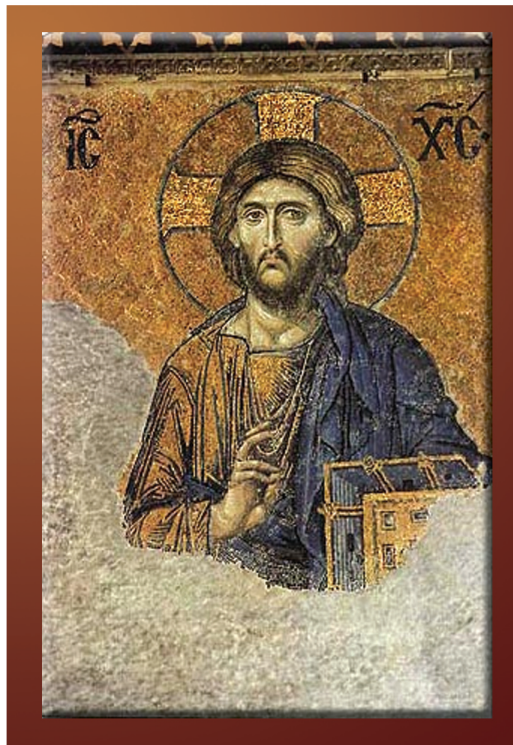
Rhetoric
